Award Amount: \$500 per year renewable up to 4 years totaling \$2,000*
Number Awarded: Two (2)
Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2023

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating high school senior who attends a school in Crawford or Union County and is accepted to an accredited trade, college, or university school.
- Applicant must be a customer or have a parent/guardian that is a customer at the time of the application deadline.

Submission Requirements:

- Completed and signed scholarship application.
- Two letters of recommendation –one from a teacher (present or past) and one from a non-family member/non-teacher.
- A minimum 300-word essay on the following topic:

Describe an experience with a peer that has impacted your life, negatively or positively, and how it shaped who you are and /or who you want to be.

*Upon renewal – GPA requirement is 3.0.

2023 Scholarship Program

The Award:

The First Federal Community Bank Scholarship consists of two (2) renewable scholarships (\$500 per year up to a total of \$2,000) between the school districts in Crawford and Union County.

The scholarship will be paid to the school or applicant after proof of enrollment and invoice from the school is presented.

To renew the following year(s), the applicant will need to provide proof of cumulative GPA - minimum of 3.0 is required for renewal - along with an invoice.

Eligibility:

The applicant or a parent/guardian must be a customer of First Federal at the time of the scholarship deadline of March 31, 2023.

The applicant must be accepted to an accredited trade, college, or university school. Dependents of Directors or Employees of FFCB are not eligible to apply.

Essay Requirements:

A minimum of 300 words typed and double spaced on a separate page discussing the topic outlined below.

Describe an experience with a peer that has impacted your life, negatively or positively, and how it shaped who you are and /or who you want to be.

Submission Instructions:

All requirements must be met for scholarship to be eligible for review. Incomplete or late packages will not be reviewed. Your scholarship package must be received by **Friday, March 31, 2023 by close of business** and can be dropped off at any of the First Federal Community Bank locations.

Results:

All finalists will be called for an interview. Winners will be determined by FFCB Scholarship Committee. All decisions shall be final. The winners will be announced at their school's award night.
